Overview: Ceeds of Peace workshops provide a 360° approach to raising peacebuilders, transforming communities by creating safe and thriving homes and schools. Workshops bring together community members, parents, families, teachers, school support staff & administrators to gain skills in supporting children and youth to be leaders in effective peacebuilding. Peacebuilders are life-ready as young adults and possess the critical "c"eeds necessary to tackle our communities' most challenging issues. Come ready to learn and be inspired to bring peace into your home, workplace, school, practice, or any environment in which you interact with children & youth. Workshops are offered on both Oahu & HI Island.

Takeaways: Participants will leave the workshops with *Peace Action Plans* for their homes, programs, schools, and classrooms. Morning sessions will offer interactive panel discussions with national and local leaders in peacebuilding. Afternoon sessions will allow participants to work in small groups to create their *Action Plans*. Trained Facilitators will be present to guide all participants. *Action Plans* may include: Civic Action Plans, Family Plans, Safe School Plans, Safe Community Plans, Family-School Partnership Plans, Integrated Curriculum Plans, among others. DOE PD credit available for certain subject areas.
