The Peacebuilding Workshop Series is designed for all adults who interact with children and youth, such as parents, caregivers, teachers, counselors, coaches, therapists, community youth workers. We all gather in the same room to learn and strategize together.

## Design of the Peacebuilding Workshop Series

There are 3 separate, in-person events that include two learning workshops (8 hours each) and one celebratory share out workshop (5 hours). The workshops normally occur over a 3 to 5-month timespan. Each event builds on the next, and there are no make-up dates. Attendance at all 3 events is encouraged for maximum benefit and impact. Light breakfast, coffee, and lunch are provided at all events. Staff support and learning materials are provided. There will also be networking opportunities for all.

During the two learning workshops, the day begins with Ceeds of Peace leadership introducing the organization to participants. Then participants will learn from leaders in the community (adult and youth), as to the "who-what-where-when-why-how" of peace building, leadership, and social-emotional learning. In the afternoons, a trained Ceeds of Peace Facilitator will guide the participants to help craft a Peace Action Plan that will benefit the participant personally, as well as the young people in their life.

## Department of Education (DOE) Professional Development (PD) Credit

The Peacebuilding Workshop Series is also offered as a for-credit PD course for select Hawaii DOE teachers and counselors (additional DOE-PDE3 registration required; please contact us for information). The registration fee covers attendance at all 3 events, food, materials, and staff support, and helps us continue our work as a public charity nonprofit organization. Attendance at all 3 events is required for HI-DOE staff enrolled in PD course.
